- Small canopy or tent (optional)

- Ice
- Umbrella insurance for the event
- Liquor license and park permits
- Security guards & wrist bands
- Food trucks & live music
- Porta-potties & washing stations
- Volunteers to assist pouring for short breaks
- 400 - 600 thirsty patrons from the community
